There are a few reminders for Week 2.

1) After-school Activities

There will be <u>no Elective Activities (EA) next week</u>. EAs will start in Week 3 when we have processed all the registrations from the newly joined students.

Fardhu-Ain classes for Muslim students will begin on Monday 11th September 2017 according to the schedule sent out earlier this week.

2) Registration for Co-Curricular Activities (CCA), Elective Activities (EA) and Prescribed Activities (PA)

3) Holiday Reading Programme

The School had sent an Online Reading Homework throughout the holidays to all students from last year's Reception - Year 6 cohorts . The Bug Club Reading Programme contains highly engaging visuals to enhance learning and keep children motivated. Working at the reading texts students develops phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and text comprehension.

Some students have dutifully read their online books.. However, others have not completed their reading assignments or not started on these at all. Teachers will follow up with these students. Could we request the help of all families to remind and impress upon our children about the benefits of reading too? Do encourage them to do some of the reading they have missed during this weekend.

Our current Reception students will embark on their Bug Club Online Reading Programme shortly.
