END-OF-YEAR PROGRESS ASSESSMENTS

As of the week beginning 17th June, all children in Years 3-5 will be taking Cambridge International Primary end-of year summative assessments. These will be administered during the week from Monday to Thursday, during allocated lesson times. The assessments should be seen as an informative opportunity to see where the learners are and through a non-threatening exam experience. The progress assessments are to gauge your child's progress in the Cambridge Core curriculum subjects (English, Maths, Science), studied through the year. This progress assessment will contribute to the 40% of the summative assessment.

All EAL students' English progress will be assessed at this time too. They will have reading support in Maths and Science to give them the best possible chance of success, facilitated by the EAL teacher.

The Year 6 children will be taking their end of year Junior School assessments, known formally as the Cambridge International Primary Checkpoint, between the days 18th - 20th June 2019

The Year 6 Cambridge Checkpoint schedule for the week is as follows: -
