TERM 1 ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019 (YEAR 6) SCHOOL TRIP - "CARING FOR ANIMALS - KUALA GANDAH ELEPHANT SANCTUARY"

This Term, the Year 6 students will be visiting an Elephant Conservation Centre or the Elephant Sanctuary; situated at Kuala Gandah, Pahang. This trip will broaden their classroom learning experience and understanding of elephants lives on a sanctuary.

The sanctuary is managed by the Malaysian Department of Wildlife and National Parks; is the shelter and conservation centre for many orphaned elephants. Being the home of endangered Asian Elephants, the Department is responsible in capturing and rehabilitating these endangered species before relocating them to other national parks throughout Malaysia.
