Considering the formal setting of the day, we would like to request that the graduates dress appropriately for the occasion. The following are the specifications to be adhered to by all attending boys and girls.

Girls are to be in white attire, may it be a dress, skirt or pants and blouse. Please note that strapless dresses, halter tops or backless dresses are not allowed. Shoulders and back should be covered and necklines should not be too low. Skirt lengths should not be shorter than 5 cm above the knee. Footwear must be formal and should be either dress shoes or sandals with a strap on the back of the heel.

Boys have to wear a collared dress shirt, dark coloured dress pants, dark coloured tie, black socks and black dress shoes.

Once again, may we remind that jeans, shorts, flip-flops, casual sandals or tennis/gym shoes are not allowed.
