VOCAL TRAINING:

An external facilitator will continue to assist our children in vocal training. The children will be trained to learn proper singing technique, as well listening to others and to sing in harmony. At the same time, they have to learn to sing to a certain pitch and be able to learn some basic rhythm in dance and movement.

Students who have been trained to sing can then be part of the MIGS Junior Show Choir.

Minimum number of students required: 20 (Only from Y2~6)

GAMELAN

This is a new activity to be introduced this Term. It is an old Malaysian Traditional Musical Instrument commonly used during Traditional Ceremonies. An external instructor will be conducting this club.

By the end of the course, students would able to:

- Understand the history of Gamelan and its development in Malaysia
- Read music notes
- Recognise the instruments in Malay Gamelan
- To learn the musical skills and technique used in playing them

Play three a few Gamelan songs.

DANCE CLUB

An external dance teacher and well known choreographer will be conducting this club. Her expertise lies in teaching young children how to dance. This is offered as an after-school activity. Students at the end of the year will go on to take part in the MIGS Talent show and can also showcase their dancing skills at any other events organized at school or out.

Minimum number of students required: 10 (Only from Y2~6)

TAEKWONDO

The Instructional Fees are to be paid to the Finance & Accounts Office before your child begins with the activity. The uniform fees, registration fees and annual fees are to be paid directly to the Instructor. It is not necessary to buy a set of new Taekwondo attire if your child has already got one. Students who are joining for the first time are to pay for all the fees while those who are already in the Taekwondo Club and they would like to continue for Term 2 are to pay Instruction Fees only.

FOOTBALL

Football is conducted by external coaches hired to facilitate a series of coaching programmes with our young football players. This is an activity in high demand from our young players and we want to provide them with the best we can, in terms of professional coaching.

Our Football coaches are:

1. Qualified Football coaches affiliated to the MSN.
2. Committed to develop our younger football players to acquire basic skills in football.

Discipline is one of the prominent characteristics emphasized in their programme. Competitions will be organised under parents' approval. Such competitions may incur separate fees, not included in the EA Fees.

A set of new football attire will be supplied to the new players for training and competition.

It is not compulsory for our students to select Football as EA but we feel that this an excellent opportunity for our younger football players to hone their skills in the game. Parents are most welcome to support their children from the sidelines during any of the competitions.

BASKETBALL

Basketball is only available to students in Years 4 - 6, both boys and girls on a Wednesday afternoon. A fee is charged from this activity and players will pay for their own basketball uniform. There will be a number of Inter School Basketball competition scheduled for our players later in the Term. More details will be sent later as the competition is confirmed.

SCOUTS

We have a number of our students who have joined Scouts throughout the last 2 terms. We will only allow our students from Years 4~6 only. Students who are currently in the group are most welcome to continue. New members are also welcome to join in.

Through our Scout activities, young Scouts learn to develop teamwork, time management, as well as become self-motivated to participate enthusiastically to reach their full potential. The fee charged helps to cover costs of the trips we have planned to visit places within Kuala Lumpur that will be organised during the year and you will notified as the events are finalised .

A one-night Scout camp in school will be organised later in the year.

Minimum number of students required: 20 (Only open to Y4~6)

SWIMMING

The swimming class will be held at the Kelab Darul Eshan (KDE) swimming pool from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. every Friday. Swimmers are to find their own way to KDE and the coaches and Mr. Charlie will meet them at the venue.

SATURDAY BASKETBALL CLUB: YEARS – 6 (BOYS AND GIRLS ONLY)

An external Basketball Coach will be conducting our coaching sessions on Saturday morning in School from 7:30a.m to 9:00 a.m. The Coach is a member of the KL Dragon's Basketball Academy Coaching Staff and a Core Coach of Junior NBA Malaysia. At present, she have been assisting a few International School in KL to promote basketball to our young players. With the recent success of our Under 11 Girls and Boys Basketball teams in the KLSL Tournament we would like to extend their knowledge and skills to another level to boost their confidence and become better players in the future

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| a) Basketball Instruction Fees | - RM 300/- per Term payable to the Accounts Office. |

FUTSAL

This is another new activity we are introducing to our EA programme. Futsal promotes better technique and it develops the players basic kicking and playing skills rapidly and also it improves their soccer skills. Due to our climate change we have noticed that either it is too hot for our beginner players or it rains more regularly in the afternoons. An indoor playing venue will be most appropriate for our young football enthuthiasts.

Futsal will be conducted at Sports Planet which is only 2 kilometers away from school. Our school bus will be arranged to transport our Futsal players to Sports Planet after school at 2:30pm The players will return to school by 4:00pm.


1. Kindly read carefully the Information Leaflet on EA attached before completing the EA Selection Form together with your child (ren).

PAYMENT FOR EA FOR TERM 1


1. Payment for EA will include
