YEAR 1 EDUCATIONAL TRIP TO FARM IN THE CITY, SRI KEMBANGAN

This term, the Year One students will be visiting 'The Farm in the City' at Sri Kembangan. This trip will extend their classroom interdisciplinary learning experience with extending their understanding of animal farm living.

At Key Stage 1, the students are introduced to the habitats of the wildlife through an environmental education. They will learn about different animals and how to care for the environment. The visit to 'The Farm in the City' helps the students understand how plants, animals and humans live together and how they are connected in our ecosystem. This trip will give an experience on the animal farm habitat, animal behaviour observation and exploring the geographical directions on the farm landscape.

- listen to different types of sounds around the farm and animals


