DANCE

An external dance teacher and well known choreographer will be conducting this club. Her expertise lies in teaching young children how to dance. This is offered as an after-school activity. We aim for our student to present at our school event to showcase their dancing skills. Minimum number of students required: 10 (Only from Y2~6)

TAEKWONDO

The Instructional Fees are to be paid to the Finance & Accounts Office before your child begins with the activity. The uniform fees, registration fees and annual fees are to be paid directly to the Instructor. It is not necessary to buy a set of new Taekwondo attire if your child has already got one. Students who are joining for the first time are to pay for all the fees while those who are already in the Taekwondo Club and they would like to continue for Term 2 are to pay Instruction Fees only.

- a) Taekwondo Instruction Fees - RM 380/- per Term payable to the Accounts Office.
- b) Registration Fees - RM 95/- (1st term - Onetime payment)
- c) Annual fees - RM 60/- (1st term - Onetime payment)
- d) Uniform Fees - RM 180/- (New students only)

FOOTBALL – FOR BOYS AND GIRLS – YR. 4 -6

Football is conducted by external coaches hired to facilitate a series of coaching programmes with our young football players. This is an activity in high demand from our young players and we want to provide them with the best we can, in terms of professional coaching.

Our Football and Futsal coaches are:

1. Qualified Football coaches affiliated to the MSN.
2. Committed to develop our younger football players to acquire basic skills in football.

Discipline is one of the prominent characteristics emphasized in their programme. Competitions will be organised under parents' approval. Such competitions may incur separate fees, not included in the EA Fees.

A set of new football attire will be ordered and paid by our new players and these can be worn during training and competition.

It is not compulsory for our students to select Football as an EA but we feel that this an excellent opportunity for our younger football players to hone their skills in the game. Parents are most welcome to support their children from the sidelines during any of the competitions. This year we are hoping to have Girls Football team.

FUTSAL:

This is available for our Years 1 – 3 boys only. It will be held at the Sports Planet just outside school. A bus will be arranged to transport our young players to the venue and they will return to school at 3:45pm in time for parental pick up.

Due to our climate change either it is too hot for our beginner players or it rains more regularly in the afternoons. An indoor playing venue will be most appropriate for our young enthusiasts.

GAMELAN:

Gamelan is slowly gaining popularity in our school. Students who have joined gamelan before can still continue this term. At the end of the course our young players would be able to:

- read music notes for the varying instrument
- recognize the instruments in Malay Gamelan
- learn the musical skills and technique used in playing these instruments.
- Extend a cultural heritage musical and traditional Malay experience

The maximum number of students will 10 only.

SCOUTS

Scouts is offered throughout the year to students in Years 4~6 only. Students who are currently in the group this Academic Year 2019/2020 are most welcome to continue. New members are also welcome to join in.

Through our Scout activities, young Scouts learn to develop teamwork, time management, as well as become self-motivated to participate enthusiastically to reach their full potential. The fee charged helps to cover costs of the trips we have planned to visit places within Kuala Lumpur that will be organised during the year and you will be notified as the events are finalised.

Minimum number of students required: 20 (Only open to Y4~6)

SWIMMING

The swimming class will be held at the Kelab Darul Eshan (KDE) swimming pool from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. every Friday. Swimmers are to find their own way to KDE and the coaches and Mr. Charlie will meet them at the venue. Parents are responsible of dropping and picking up their children at the end of the swimming lessons at 4:00pm.

SATURDAY BASKETBALL CLUB: YEARS 1 – 6 (BOYS AND GIRLS)

An external Basketball Coach will be conducting our coaching sessions on Saturday morning in School from 7:30a.m to 9:00 a.m. The Coach is a member of the KL Dragon's Basketball Academy Coaching Staff and a Core Coach of Junior NBA Malaysia. At present, she has been assisting a few International School in KL to promote basketball to our young players. With the recent success of our Under 11 Girls and Boys Basketball teams in the KLSL Tournament we would like to extend their knowledge and skills to another level to boost their confidence and become better players in the future.
