I have been invited to join a collaborative meeting to discuss the issues on Thursday the 9th of April 2020. This session will be presented by:

I believe this is a vital step as CAIE informed us previously that: -

The process we will use to provide grades for students will be a collaborative one with schools.

The decision on grades to be awarded to candidates will be made by Cambridge, using our own evidence combined with evidence from schools.

Our approach will be to ask schools to collaborate with us as we make evidence-based decisions about grades for each candidate in each subject they have entered for in the May/June 2020 exam series for Cambridge IGCSE.

I have registered to attend this meeting and will update you as soon as possible on the conclusions and information from the CAIE group.
