## **MOCK EXAMINATIONS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022**

We would like to inform you that the Year 11 students will be completing their Mock Examinations from the 6<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

### **EXAM REGULATIONS**

Your son/daughter has recently received a copy of the examination regulations to be used as an essential reference. The mock examinations form an important part in the preparation of examination success, not only in the academic feedback they provide, but also an essential opportunity to practice completing assessments under full examination conditions. It is therefore essential that students are aware of all procedures and regulations so errors are avoided prior to the real examinations.

### **EQUIPMENT**

Students must make sure they have all the correct equipment including 'spares' for all examinations. All items of equipment, pens, pencils, mathematical instruments, etc. should be visible to the invigilators at all times. They must either use a transparent pencil case or clear plastic bag. They are only allowed to bring in a bottle of water and the label must be removed from the bottle. Pens should be black ink or ballpoint. No correction pens or correction fluids are allowed.

For mathematics and science examinations, students should make sure their calculators conform to the examination regulations. If in doubt, check with your teacher. Students must remove any covers or instructions before entering the exam hall and make sure batteries are new.

### **PHONES & OTHER ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT**

Students are not allowed to bring any electronic equipment into the examination room, the school's advice is students must leave their mobile phone/MP3 players etc at home as they will not be allowed to take them into the examination room. Anyone found in the possession of a mobile phone during the examination will be reported to the Examination Board and may be disqualified from that examination and any subsequent exams. The school takes no responsibility for equipment brought on site. As Smart watches and wearable devices become ever present, students are also prohibited from bringing these into the examination room. If you are in doubt about which items are allowed, please consult Mr Shahul.
