Dear Parents/Guardians of Year 7,
Latest Update on Quarantine Period for Year 7 Students

I would like to provide an update regarding the quarantine period for all Year 7 students. There are a few students in Year 7 who are still 11 years old and will only turn 12 this year in a few more months. They have only received their first dose of vaccination for now. Based on the ministry's guideline, those who are partially vaccinated or unvaccinated are required to undergo 7 days of quarantine.

Revised Quarantine Period for Year 7 'Close Contact' Students

Although

- **Fully vaccinated students (received 2 doses of vaccine)** are required to be in quarantine for **5 days only** by staying at home from Saturday, **26th February (Saturday) till 2nd March 2022 (Wednesday)**.

And

- **Partially vaccinated / unvaccinated students** are required to be in quarantine for **7 days** from Saturday, **26th February (Saturday) till 4th March 2022 (Friday)**.

In order to maintain parity and access for all, we have decided to allow all Year 7 students (those who have completed both 5 days and 7 days of quarantine at home) to return to school **together** on the same day which will be next week **Monday, 7th March 2022**.

Return to School

1. Please repeat a Saliva Antigen Test for your son/daughter at home on **6th March 2022 (Sunday)** and kindly submit the test results at the link provided in the email before returning to School the next day.
2. Students who are well without any symptoms may return to school on **7th March 2022 (Monday)**.
3. If your son/daughter happens to show symptoms as mentioned above after the quarantine period, please allow him/her to rest at home, visit a doctor and get the doctor's advice before returning to school. This is for the safety and well being of all other students at school and kindly submit his/her MC to me.

May all Year 7 students be well without any symptoms. The academic team will be in touch with you in regards to their online learning at home. Thank you.
