EA SELECTION FOR TERMS 1 – 3:

PAYMENT FOR EA :


1. Payment for EA will include:
 - External Coach Fees
 - Materials required for the activity
 - Hiring of the venue
 - Transportation charges to and from the venue (if any)
 - Administrative fee charged by the School

2. Kindly fill in the Selection Form with the payment slip and attach the cash in exact amount in a sealed envelope to be handed over to Mr Khairul / Ms Delphy for verification purpose before the amount is submitted to the Accounts department for payment. Receipts will be sent home on the same day.
3. The deadline for submission of the EA Selection Form is 26th of September, 2022 but kindly note – First come first served, as we have to stick to the stipulated number of team members.
4. Also, do take note that NO Refunds will be permitted once payment has been made for the EA you and your child have selected as the payment will be forwarded by the school to the External coach and the venue booking.

BEATBOX CLUB: This is a new activity that is going to be introduced to the students. The children will be trained by an external facilitator to engineer sounds and compose them into a structure using their vocals. They will learn to copy the drum sounds and even create their own special sounds. They will also learn how to sing and beatbox at the same time.

Minimum number of students: 5 (Only from Y3~6)

GAMELAN CLUB: This is a new activity to be introduced this Term. It is an old Malaysian Traditional musical Instrument commonly used during Traditional Ceremonies. An external instructor will be conducting this club.

By the end of the course, students would able to:

- Understand the history of Gamelan and its development in Malaysia
- Read music notes
- Recognise the instruments in Malay Gamelan and the music skills used in playing them
- Learn to play Gamelan songs

Maximum number of students: 12 (Only from Y4~6)

DANCE CLUB: An external dance teacher (and well known choreographer) will be conducting this club. Her expertise lies in teaching young children how to dance. This is offered as an after-school activity. Students at the end of the year will go on to take part in the MIGS Talent show and can also showcase their dancing skills at any other events organized at school or at other venues.

Minimum number of students: 5 (Only from Y2~6)

TAEKWONDO: The Instructional Fees are to be paid to the Finance & Accounts Office before your child begins with the activity. The uniform fees, registration

fees and annual fees are to be paid directly to the Instructor. It is not necessary to buy a set of new Taekwondo attire if your child has already got one:

Payable to the MIGS Accounts Office:

A. Taekwondo Instruction Fees- RM 360/- per Term

Payable to the Taekwondo Coach:

A. Registration Fees - RM 95/- (1st term - One time payment)

B. Annual fees - RM 60/- (1st term - One time payment)

C. Uniform Fees - RM 190/- (New students only, to be paid to the coach)

Maximum number of students: 30 (Only from Y2~6)

FOOTBALL: Football is conducted by external coaches hired to facilitate a series of coaching programmes with our young football players. This is an activity in high demand from our young players and we want to provide them with the best we can, in terms of professional coaching.

Our Football coaches are:

1. Qualified Football coaches affiliated to the MSN.
2. Committed to developing our younger football players to acquire basic skills in football.

Discipline is one of the prominent characteristics emphasised in their programme. Competitions will be organised under parents' approval. Such competitions may incur separate fees, not included in the EA Fees.

A set of new football attire will be supplied to the players for training and competition. It is not compulsory for our students to select Football as EA. but we do feel that this is an excellent opportunity for our younger football players to hone their skills in the game. Parents are most welcome to support their children from the sidelines during any of the competitions.

Maximum number of students: 50 (Only from Y3~6)

BASKETBALL: In Term 1, Basketball is only available to students in Years 3~6, both boys and girls. Our Under-11 MIGS team will be selected from these Year Groups to participate in the KLSL Under-11 boys and girls tournament in November. Details of this event will be announced closer to date. A fee is charged from this activity as we will be hiring a qualified and dedicated Basketball coach to train our youngsters.

Minimum number of students: 20 (Only from Y3~6)

SWIMMING: The swimming class will be held at the Kelab Darul Ehsan (KDE) swimming pool from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. every Friday. Swimmers are to be sent to the KDE Club by their parents and the coaches and Mr Khairul will meet them at the venue.

Maximum number of students: 30 (Only open to Y2~6)
